

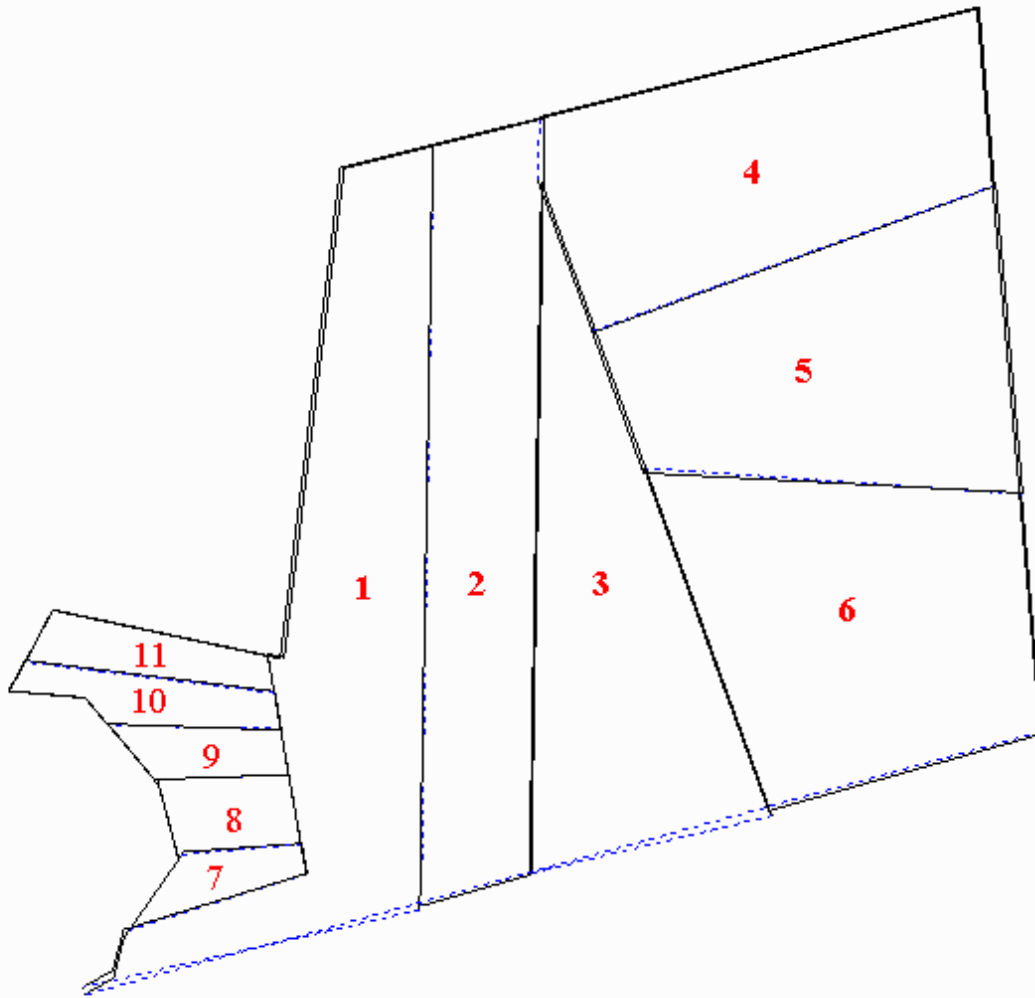
Susanna Beatty Property

The Beatty House located on Route 26 near Ceresville is considered the oldest house in Frederick County. Susanna Beatty (Widow) obtained a deed for 1000 acres from Daniel Dulany in 1732. In 1739 the land was split up amongst her 6 children.
