

# Abraham Lynn Farm

## Middleburg Carroll County

Abraham Lynn obtained the farm (226 acres) from his father Henry and wife Jacobberry Lynn in 1811 (Fr Co. Deed WR 40-538). Land was part of tracts Good Intent & Good Hope. Frederick County 1798 Tax shows a log house & barn. The land remained in the Lynn family until the late 1890's. Lynn Family burial ground is located about 500' north of the house.

The original Lynn house was across the road on the north side of the pond and is no longer standing. The second Lynn house on the other side of the road was built in the early 1890's and has undergone major renovations.

of John Bowman, the late E. A. Clabaugh,  
R. W. Walden and others, and being the  
same land which Daniel Lynn, deceased,  
owned and resided on at the time of his death,  
containing.

147½ ACRES OF LAND, MORE or LESS.

The improvements thereon consist of two  
dwelling houses, one of which  
has been recently built, large  
bank barn, 2 wagon sheds, corn  
and hog house, 2 corn cribs, 1  
carriage house, spring house, with never fail-  
ing spring of water; also well of excellent  
water convenient to each of the dwellings and  
also a well of water at the stock yard. There  
is also a fine apple orchard and quite a num-  
ber and variety of other good fruit trees in  
bearing. There is also about 12 acres of good  
oak and hickory timber on this property.



This farm is conveniently located as to  
churches, schools, mills and stores, and is a  
very desirable red land farm, in a high state  
of cultivation.
