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John Wagner Sr. 1734-1808	Fr. Co.	John Wagner Sr. 1734-1808 (Fr. Co. Deed JS 5-121 1816) Salome (Sally) Wagner (Fr. Co. Will GME 1-377 1832) Wall around family burying ground to be repaired. Believed to be south of the Methodist Church in Libertytown. Ninian Beall (Innkeeper) (1724?-1790) Mary Beall (Died after 1777)	Mo. Co.	Ninian Beall (1724?-1790) in 1750 obtained land (Gravelly Ridge Fr. Co. Patent# 1710 50 acres). In 1762 Ninian Beall added to Gravelly Ridge and patented (Resurvey on Gravelly Ridge Fr. Co. Patent# 3468 810 acres). Ninian Beall sold a portion of this land to his son in law Benjamin Edwards in 1777 (Mo. Co. Deed A-10 700 acres). Benjamin Edwards in 1786 had the land resurveyed into the tract Mount Pleasant (Mo. Co. Patent# 296 711 acres). Benjamin & Margaret Edwards of Nelson Co. KT. sold the land in 1815 (Mo. Co. Deed S-19-296-Family burying ground). The original 1750 tract Gravelly Ridge (50 acres) is part of the tract Mount Pleasant. Is this the burial location of Ninian & Mary Beall? Darnestown is located within the tract Mount Pleasant. Richard Green (1750?-1818) Ann Green	Mo. Co.	Richard Green (D. 1818) obtained the land in 1796 (Mo. Co. Deed G-294). Land was resurveyed into the tract Pleasant Farm in 1800 (PG. Co. Patent# 1706 207.25 acres). Richard Green died in 1818 and willed the land to his son Allen Green (Mo. Co. Will L-88 1818). Allen Green sold the land in 1818 (Mo. Co. Deed U-382 257 acres-Reserving ¼ acre for graveyard). Land now owned by P.E.P. Co. On the

Ralph Holt (1735?-1777) Ann Holt (1744?-1777)	Mo. Co.	Land obtained by Ralph Holt (Deed not located). Land willed to son Laurence O. Holt (Mo. Co. Will A-5 1777). Sale of Ralph Holt land (Mo. Co. Deed R-114 1814-Burying ground listed) by his son Laurence O. Holt to Jesse Leach. 2 nd deed (Mo. Co. U-387 1819-Mentions burying ground. Mapping shows it to be at the Woodmont Country Club 1201 Rockville Pike Rockville MD. Area of 39.063567° -77.137942° Not listed on Find A Grave
Zachariah Linthicum (1735-1808)	Mo. Co.	Zachariah Linthicum (1735-1809) first starting obtaining multiple parcels of land in the 1790's which make up the farm. Zachariah Linthicum (1735-1809) willed the land to his sons (Mo. Co. Will F-197 1808). John Linthicum (Son of Zachariah Linthicum) sells the land in 1814 (Mo. Co. Deed R-193 571 acres-Graveyard listed). Part of the land is now subdivisions and in Seneca Creek State Park. Germantown Road Germantown MD. Area of 39.127749° -77.284961°
Allen Mackbee (D. 1796)	Mo. Co.	Allen Mackbee (D. 1796) obtained the land in 1796 (Mo. Co. Deed G-325). Sold by his wife Deborah Mackbee in 1820 (Mo. Co. Deed V-192 on the Hawlings River-1/8 acre for graveyard 1820). Allen Mackbee (Mo. Co. Will C-312 1796). Mapping shows it to be in the Hawlings River SVP. Hawlings River east of Georgia Avenue Brookville MD. Area of 39.210110° -77.058706°
Nathaniel Magruder (1726-1798) Elizabeth Magruder (1738-1790)	Mo. Co.	Sale of Nathaniel Magruder (1726-1798) land (Mo. Co. Deed L-362 1804-Graveyard reserved) by Aquilla Magruder. Location confirmed by 1977 Montgomery Co. Property Tax Map GP342. Wooded lot next to 10024 Woodhill Road Bethesda MD. William Offutt III (1729-1786) Elizabeth Offutt (1730-1812)	Mo. Co.	William Offutt I (1670-1734) obtained the land Cleverwell in 1715 by Patent EE 6-134 600 acres. This was increased in 1728 with Cleverwell Enlarged (PG. Co. Patent# 526 2000 acres). In 1725 William Offutt II (1702-1737) was deeded the land (PG. Co. Deed I-692) by his father William Offutt I. The land where the graveyard is located made its way to William Offutt III. (1729-1786). Land willed to his sons

		<p>in 1786 (Mo. Co. Will B-219). The land was sold (Mo. Co. Deed R-172 1814-Burying ground listed) by son Baruch Offutt to John B. Clagett (Etal). Land then sold to Henry Stone (Mo. Co. Deed Y-408 1826-Burying ground not mentioned). Area today is a subdivision. Property line of both parcels is at the graveyard</p>
William Willett (D. 1785)	Mo. Co.	<p>Land was obtained by Edward Willett Jr. (1702-1772) PG. Co. Deed Y-331 1741 Tract-Scotland & Addition to Scotland (PG. Co. Patent# 111 1748). Edward Willett Jr. (1702-1772) willed the land (Fr. Co. Will A-418 1772) to his sons William (D. 1785) & Ninian. William Willett (D. 1785) willed the land to his son Edward Willett (Mo. Co. Will B-204 1785). Edward Willett (Son of William Willett D. 1785) sold the land in 1811 (Mo. Co. Deed P-353-Burying ground mentioned). Unknown how many members of the early Willett family are buried here. The land sold by Edward Willett in 1811 sets on the south side of Montrose Road and extends to the west side of I-270. Area now is a subdivision with a large area of woods next to I-270. Area of 39.053384° -77.158020°. Not listed on Find A Grave</p>
William Williams Family	Mo. Co.	<p>Charles Perry (1750?-1819) obtained the land in 1805 (Mo. Co. Deed M-164-Graveyard listed) from Charles Williams. The land was part of Hobsons Choice (Fr. Co. Patent# BCGS 8-243 408 acres) patented to William Williams in 1758. The heirs of Charles Perry sale the land in 1823 (Mo. Co. Deed X-93-Graveyard listed) to Addison Belt. Is this the burial location of William Williams (1700-1787) & Family? Shady Grove Road & I-270 Rockville MD. Area is heavily developed. Area of 39.106880° -77.186319° Not Listed on Find A Grave</p>

Co.</p>	<p>Samuel Piper records show Mary Fessler (1749-1821) & Elizabeth Fessler (1773-1833) along with 2 other named gravestones and 3 graves with plain stones. Graveyard on the Frank Stouffer Farm. Graveyard is in the backyard of 13729 Franks Run Road Smithburg MD. 39.692984° -77.572802° https://www.findagrave.com/cemetery/2427536/memorial-search</p>
<p>Rudolph Herr Sr. (1752-1822)</p>	<p>Wa. Co.</p>	<p>Rudolph Herr Sr. (1752-1822) obtained the land in 1807 (Wa. Co. Deed S-926 300 Acres) Samuel Piper records show Rudolph Herr Sr. (1752-1822) with wife Nancy with 3 other named gravestones and several unnamed gravestones. <p>John Malone (1725-1783)</p>	<p>Wa. Co.</p>	<p>John Malone obtains land in 1760 (Fr. Co. Deed F-1269 100 Acres-Content). 1783 Washington County Tax shows Susannah Malone with 50 acres of Content. Benjamin Malone (Wa. Co. Will C-103 1821) names brothers Elias, James & John Malone. Benjamin Malone (Heirs) sale the 100 acres to James Malone Etal. (Wa. Co. Deed FF-511 100 Acres-Content 1821). Samuel Piper records show James Malone (1775-1845) with 4 other named stones and one stone marked 1798. <p>Samuel Middlekauf (1799-1860)</p>	<p>Wa. Co.</p>	<p>Samuel Piper records show Samuel Middlekauff (1799-1860) along with parents Peter & Hannah Middlekauff and sister Mary Ann Middlekauff. Maryland Historical Trust file states Middlekauff Graveyard on hill west of the house. Graveyard on farm of Wilber W. Wiles (Wa. Co. Deed 204-598 1937). <p>Conrad Ringer (D. 1798)</p>	<p>Wa. Co.</p>	<p>Land where the graveyard is located was obtained by Conrad Ringer (D. 1798) in 1785 (Wa. Co. Deed D-558 200 acres). Conrad Ringer willed the farm (Wa. Co. A-385 1798) to his sons John, Peter & Robert. Samuel Piper records show Peter Ringer (D. 1850 Age 75) with 14 other named stones and over a dozen no name plain stones. Graveyard on the Elmer Thomas Farm with land around the graveyard now house lots. Maryland Historical trust file below has photos of the graveyard. <p>Martin Waltz (1716-1777)</p>	<p>Wa. Co.</p>	<p>Samuel Piper records show Martin Waltz (1716-1777) and fifteen named stones with one unnamed stone. Graveyard on John Waltz Farm.
