Larkin Buckingham (D. 1865 Age 81)	Carroll Co.	Larkin Buckingham (D. 25 Jun 1865 age 81) died in Franklin District. He was born in Baltimore County and parents were William and Mary Buckingham. He died of dropsy and had a home burial. Carroll County MD. Cemetery Book Buckingham (7-10) William Buckingham Farm (Graveyard may be gone) Fleming Road Mt. Elizabeth Jane Leister (D. 1865 Age 5)	Carroll Co.	Elizabeth Jane Leister (D. 5 Sep 1865 age 5) Finksburg. Daughter Abraham and Lavina Leister. She was buried in the home graveyard. Abraham Leister bought the Flinn Garner land in 1852 (Ca. Co. Deed JBB 13-355). Same as Flinn Garner Cemetery (Carroll County MD. Cemetery Book 4-25). Cemetery no longer exist. Frederick Baptist Church	Frederick Co.	Baptist Church of Frederick Town (Fr. Co. Deed WR 10-298 1791). Find A Grave shows Conrad Keller (1765-1821) disinterred from the First Baptist Cemetery. Mt. Olivet records show Jacob Lease (1769-1847) and family moved to Mt. Olivet in 1882 from Baptist Graveyard. Church not listed in Names In Stone. Anna Barbara Bauer (D. 1807 Age 60)	Frederick Co.	Gravestone found on the Homer Remsberg Farm. Holter Road Middletown MD. Area of 39.428378° -77.536621° Source: Western Maryland Genealogy Vol. 4 No. 4 Oct 1988. No further information.

James Cooper Jr. (1764-1838)	Frederick Co.	James Cooper Sr. (D. 1808) father of James Cooper (1764-1838) obtained the land in 1778 (Fr. Co. Deed RP-457). Sold to son James Cooper (1764-1838) in 1799 (Fr. Co. Deed WR 18-437). Land remained in Cooper Family until 1838. Frederick Mt. Olivet records show James Cooper (1764-1838) relocated to Mt. Thomas Maynard (1776-1830)	Frederick Co.	Frederick Mt. Olivet records show Thomas Maynard (1776-1830) and wife Ruth Maynard (1789-1855) were moved to Frederick Mt. Olivet in 1868. Joseph West (D. 1797)	Frederick Co.	Benjamin West (D. 28 Nov 1840) Fr. Co. Will GME 2-560. Purchase and erect grave stones over the remains of my father, mother and sister Arabella. Graveyard to be enclosed with post & rail fence. Benjamin West and Arabella West gravestones moved to Saint Marks Cemetery Petersville Frederick County. Unknown if parents stones Joseph West (D. 1797) & Sarah Hilleary West (D. 1807) were moved also. Eleanor Hilleary West (Wife of Patrick McGill) is the sister of Benjamin West and children of Joseph West. Same as Hook/McGill #156-Names In Stone. Graveyard mentioned in Fr. Co. Equity

James Trail Sr. (1720?-1798)	Montgomery Co.	Montgomery Co, MD - Judgment Book - 1814-1821 (Page 530-534) Trail & Clopper Land - "Rock Head", 58.5 acres, on the east side of Seneca. (Was homestead of his father, James, and devised to Archibald). Previously to James Trail in April 1744 (then PG Co). Exception - a square of about 20 feet for Trail Family Graveyard. John Leatherwood (B. 1782 D.?) Jesse Leatherwood (B. 1823 D. 1876)	Carroll Co.	Find A Grave shows buried Elizabeth Gillis & John Leatherwood land. John Leatherwood is the son of Samuel Leatherwood III (1754-1821). Samuel Leatherwood III gravestone found 1991 at Leatherwood/Gunn/Fleming Family Cemetery Carroll County Burial 7-17 Gillis Road & Rt. 27. Believed John & Jesse Leatherwood are buried here. Tudle/Toodle Town (African American)	Fr. Co.	Frederick Co. County death certificate for John Henry Cooper Jr. (Colored D. 13 Sep 1920) Toodletown Lane & Fingerboard Road Monrovia MD. Area of 39.346156° -77.286337° (Source: Marilyn Veek)
Jacob Geisy (D. 26 August 1829)	Frederick Co.	Confusing information: States buried on his farm in Wolfsville. In the listing for his son Peter Geisy it shows his parents were buried on the family farm in Liberty.

Greenberry Griffith (D. 1897)	Frederick Co.	<p>Confusing information: Find A Grave shows buried in New Market. Frederick Newspaper (The News 13 Oct 1897) States died in Arkansas remains brought east and interred in family burying ground this county. His parents and the majority of his brothers & sisters are buried in Beallsville Montgomery Co. MD. From his obituary it appears he is unmarried. Why was he buried in the supposed Griffith Graveyard New Market which shows only one burial? Hilleary Family	Frederick Co.	<p>Listed in Names In Stone as Petersville-Hilleary-Two names listed</p> <p>Hilleary, Ann no dates Hilleary, Sally died 4/11/1800 aged 8 years, 10 months, 9 days</p> <p>Unknown if it exists or ever did. Several Hilleary Farms located in the Petersville area.</p> <p>Source: Names In Stone shows information contributed by Dr. B.F.M. MacPherson</p>
Hook/McGill #156 (Names In Stone)	Frederick Co.	<p>Same as Joseph West Family Graveyard. Holdcraft shows two stones back of the house. Only one found in book: Mary Hook McGill (D. 1833). Catholic Church Road Petersville MD. 39.359139° -77.616135°</p>
Ridge Church Cemetery	Frederick Co.	<p>Listed in Carroll County MD. Find A Grave. Should be Frederick Co. MD. Also known as Mountain View Church. Holdcraft shows six burials. Private residence has been added on to the church building. Three stones remain just behind building.
