<p>John Jacob Haines 1772-1847 Isaac Haines (Son) 1827-1828</p>	<p>Ca. Co.</p>	<p>John Jacob Haines and son Isaac Haines were relocated to Sams Creek Church of the Brethren from his son's Samuel A. Haines farm on Dennings Road. Find A Grave states "Married to Mary Magdalene Kellinger who was born in 1798, died 30 January 30, 1841 during childbirth". Burial site of mother and son are unknown according to Haines family history. Westminster MD. Area of 39.505955° - 77.057091°. <p>Conrad Foltz (D. 1784) Margaret Foltz (Wife)</p>	<p>Fr. Co.</p>	<p>According to the book History and Legends Urbana District 1976 it states "For years researchers have hoped to find the family cemetery. A burial ground had been recently located at a new subdivision of the property". Skeletal remains and artifacts whose age has been authenticated by archeologists. No further information located. It is unknown if this is the burial ground of Conrad Foltz. Park Mills Road. Park Mills MD. Conrad Foltz property with a glass house was sold to John F. Amelung Fr. Co. Deed WR 5-520 (1784). Maryland Historical Trust file makes no mention of a graveyard on the Amelung site. Area of 39.300989° -77.401828°</p>
<p>Major Roger Johnson & Family (1748-1831)</p>	<p>Fr. Co.</p>	<p>Find A Grave states "Graves moved to Frederick Mt. Olivet but the cemetery has no record of Roger Johnson being moved there". A monument from the 1930's was erected in tribute to the family. The land called Bloomsbury went to his son James Johnson (1794-1867). Fr. Co. Deed DSB 2-32 (1867) shows his wife Emily Johnson selling the land to the Windsor Brothers except right of way to and from the graveyard with privilege of burying the dead. Carrie Jones (African American)	Ho. Co.	Carrie Jones D. 10 Oct 1916 Age 35 in Ellicott City. Certificate shows buried in Family Burying Ground. Further research needed. Parents: Last name Giles

Harriett Madden (African American)	Ho. Co.	Harriett Madden D. 18 Sep 1917 Age 84 near Elk Ridge. Certificate shows buried on Private Ground. Further research needed. Husband: James Madden Parents: David Cross & Unknown
James Madden (African American)	Ho. Co.	James Madden D. 28 mar 1915 Age 75 near Elk Ridge. Certificate shows buried on Private Ground. Further research needed. Husband of Harriett Madden Parents: George Madden & Unknown
Kate Pearson (African American)	Ho. Co.	Kate Pearson (D. 26 Jan 1919 Age 70) near Ellicott. Certificate shows buried in Family Cemetery. Further research needed Parents: Henson Pearson & Kate Pearson

Smith Family Cemetery (African American)	Ho. Co.	Two death certificates located showing burial in Smith Family Cemetery. Further research needed. John G. Smith D. 15 July 1913 Age 22 in Ellicott City Parents: Amos Smith & Laura F. Dorsey Betsey E. Snowden D. 5 Oct 1916 Age 80 near Ellicott Parents: Samuel W. Smith & Mary Smith
Snells Cemetery (African American)	Ho. Co.	Seven death certificates showing burial in the Snell cemetery none of which shows information on a Snell family member. Snell Cemetery believed to be on the property of Dennis Snell (1798-1881) which became Snelltown. Dennis Snell first obtains property in 1850 Ho. Co. Deed 9-437 (6 acres) and his wife Anna Snell Ho. Co. Deed 42-378 1880 (46 acres). No deeds mention a burial ground. Current location unknown further deed research needed. Snelltown MD. Area of 39.122871° -76.837277° Frank M. Catty J. Widerman (African American)	Ho. Co.	Catty J. Widerman D. 22 Jan 1917 Age 40 in Ellicott. Certificate shows buried in Tuckers Family Cemetery. Further research needed. Parents: John Bartle & Margaret M. Tucker
Amy Williams (African American)	Ho. Co.	Amy Williams D. 26 June 1922 Age 90 in Ellicott. Certificate shows buried in Family Cemetery. Further research needed. Parents: Unknown
Henrietta Williams (African American)	Ho. Co.	Henrietta Williams D. 1 Apr 1917 Age 70 near Poplar Springs. Certificate shows buried in Home Burial Ground near Poplar Springs Ho. Co. Further research needed. Parents: Benjamin Taylor & Mary Fowler
Youngs Cemetery (African American) Jonestown Ho. Co.	Ho. Co.	Two death certificates located showing burial in Youngs Cemetery. Believed to be on the property of Moses Young (B.1850) & Wife Cecilia Anderson (B.1845). Moses Young obtains land in 1903 Ho. Co. Deed 76-599 (1 acre). Current location unknown further deed research needed. Henry R. Scott D. 10 June 1923 Age 10 Mos. in Ellicott City Parents: Oliver Scott & Lottie Young Henry Young D. 6 June 1922 Age 40 in Ellicott City Parents: Moses Young & Cecelia Anderson
