Philip Harding obtained the land in 1776 (Fr. Co. Deed BD 2 258-260) and died at age 44. Land then went to son Christian Harding who obtained a patent on the land called Establishment (Fr. Co. #1287) in 1788. Christian Harding (1766-1848) willed the land to his son Philip Harding in 1848. Philip Harding who married Rebecca Buckey then deeded the land to their daughter Virginia McCaffery in 1872 (Fr. Co. CM 9-372). In 1905 the land was sold (Equity Case STH 3-259) to John C. & Jessie Buckey. John C. Buckey was the grandson of Rebecca Buckey Harding's brother Ezra Buckey. In 1912 the land was sold out of the family to Walter E. Burrall (Fr. Co. Deed 300-120). Fr. Co. Plat Book 53-94 (1994) shows a burial ground 500' northwest of the Harding house.
