Names: Unknown	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-41. States 14 graves located during construction of the Law Enforcement Driver Training Facility. Archeological dig was conducted and remains were found after examination to be Caucasian from the late 18 th and early 19 th century. Early land owners were the Shipley, Towson, Elder and Brown Families. Graveyard Source: Maryland Historical Trust File 18CR239. Slack Road Sykesville MD. Area of 39.376544°-76.946816°
Harry Bell D. 1860 Son of Henry & Lizzie Bell Elizabeth Bell Wife of Dr. Henry Bell D. 1854 Age 19	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-39. Several Bell headstones found in the vicinity of White Rock Road. Cemetery was present in the 1920's with headstones moved to edge of the woods on Martz Road. Old cemetery was plowed over. Location of Harry Bell headstone or any other is unknown. Martz Road & White Rock Road Sykesville MD. Area 39.394032° -76.998515°
Bennett Family Samuel Bennett 1749-1817 Honor Tevis Bennett 1750-1834	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-30. Carroll Phillips a Bennett descendant recalled the old cemetery on east side of Oklahoma Road near Mineral Hill Road. Stated in 1940's or 1950's headstones were moved. Land where farm is located was willed by Samuel Bennett (1749-1817) to son Rezin Bennett 1780-1835 (Ba. Co. Will Vol. 10-280 1817). Rezin Bennett 1780-1835 willed the farm to his nephew Samuel Bennett (of Samuel) Ba. Co. Will Vol. 15-249 1835. Ca. Co. Deed JBB 43-446 1874 .Samuel T. Bennett (D. 1882) is granted the estate of Samuel Bennett (of Samuel). Samuel T. Bennett (D. 1882) is buried at Old Oakland Cemetery Eldersburg MD. No headstones found. Oklahoma Road at Mineral Hill Road Eldersburg MD. 39.414777° -76.914166°

Several crude fieldstones located with one marked with letter "B". Ca. Co. Deed WAMCK 31-509 1865 Henry & Sevilla Bixler to Samuel Snyder 22 square foot family burying ground reserved by Henry Bixler. Fridinger Mill Road & Albert Rill Road Manchester MD. Area of 39.653893° -76.929380° Henry (1824-1909) & Sevilla Bixler buried Mt. Olivet York PA. George Bixler (1794-1854) & Lydia Bixler buried Manchester Cemetery Manchester MD. George Bixler (1794-1854) inherited the farm from his father Christian Bixler 1760-1824 (Ba. Co. Will Vo. 12-296 1824)</p>

Conoway Family Zachariah Conoway D. 1848 Helen Conoway (Wife)	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-31. States in 1948 two gravestones were found (Zachariah Conoway D. 1848 & ?, Garretson D. 1815) in a dump near Bollinger Mill Road & Mineral Hill Road. Also reported as many as 25 headstones were under fill dirt. Zachariah Conoway D. 1848 willed to his sons (Ca. Co. Will 1-492 1848) Zachariah & Charles Conoway 125 acres part of Conoways Venture Improved & Beasemans Discovery Enlarged that was willed to him by his father Charles Conoway (1748-1811) Ba. Co. Will 9-154 1811). Charles Conoway (1748-1811) also willed farms to sons Joshua & Archibald Conoway. John Conoway (1717-1799) patented Conoways Venture Improved (Ba. Co. # 1179 368 Acres 1769). Members of the Conoway Family are known to be living in this area on into the late 1800's as shown in the early Carroll County Atlas maps. Location of the two headstones is unknown. Bollinger Mill Road & Mineral Hill Road. Area of 39.442893° -76.916256°
Jones Family Cemetery	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 4-37. Cemetery located on the west side of Emory Road near Emory Church Road. Headstones found include Eleanor Jones (Died 1812 Age 46). Included were other headstones of Jones Family members who died between 1827 and 1847. Headstones moved in 1951 to Emory United Methodist Church in Finksburg MD. Area of 39.529698° -76.858799°
George W. Manro 1810-1891 Elizabeth Kelly Manro B. 1811	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-26 shows in 1990 a resident of Strawbridge Estates found two Manro headstones among construction debris on his property. Headstones for George W. Manro and wife Elizabeth Manro were moved to Wesley Freedom United Methodist Church Eldersburg. Original burial ground was at Johnsville Road & Sykesville Road Eldersburg MD. Early Carroll County Atlas maps show G.W. Manro at same location. Area of 39.416410° -76.946746°
Nathan Manro (D. 1827)	Ca. Co.	Catherine Manro Will Ca. Co. JMP 1-42 (D. 1838) states purchase headstone & footstone for my late husband and son John. Catherine Welsh married Nathan Manro in 1788. Ca. Co. Burial list shows John Manro (D. 1830) with

		stone moved from destroyed family cemetery on Strawbridge Estates in Eldersburg to Holy Trinity in 1994. Eldersburg MD. Area of 39.417751° -76.950404°
Cornelius Mercer	Ca. Co.	Ca. Co. Deed 33-323 (1866) first mention of graveyard Ca. Co. Deed 538-320 (1973) last mention of graveyard. Land bought by Carroll Co. Board of Commissioners in 1980 for landfill. Carroll County Cemeteries 6-43 states cemetery was destroyed when a motorcycle group built a racing strip. Kabik Ct. Woodbine MD. Area of 39.356152° -77.028208°
Patterson George Patterson Sr. 1796-1869	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-37. States Patterson Family Cemetery (aka. Sunnyside) was located on land originally acquired by William Patterson in 1827 by patent called Springfield (Ba. Co. # 4583 1378 Acres). George Patterson Sr. (son of William Patterson). Land became Springfield State Hospital. Records at the Historical Society of Carroll County Maryland show Lot 18 (2.75 acres) of Springfield was the graveyard lot. Location of George Patterson Sr. (1796-1869) is unknown.6655 Sykesville Road. Area of 39.385637° -76.959295°
Phillips Family Uriel Phillips 1774-1852 Catherine Phillips 1812-1860>	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-30. List Ca. Co. Deed 112-39 1909. Eliza J. Phillips (Wife of William H. Phillips 1822-1885) to Frank Nickoles to exclude the family graveyard. Eliza J. Phillips 1833-1912 (Wife of William H. Phillips 1822-1885) are buried at Old Oakland Cemetery Eldersburg MD. Uriel Phillips D. 1852 willed the land to sons William H. & Joshua Phillips (Ca. Co. Will JB 2-15 1852) after wife Catherine Phillips death. Land Uriel Phillips 1774-1852 lived on was part of the land willed by Thomas Phillips (Ba. Co. Deed WG 149-606 1819) to children Uriel, Thomas Sr., John, Samuel, Nathan and Solomon Phillips along with Elizabeth Bennett (Wife of Robert Bennett). No headstones found. 1850 Carroll County Census Nathan Phillips age 80 is living next to Uriel Phillips age 76. Mineral Hill Road and Frost Creek Road Eldersburg MD. No Area of 39.416440° -76.912364°
Jonathan Plowman 1717-1795 Elizabeth Plowman 1720-1788	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 1-33. Ba. Co. Will Vol. 5-173 1795 Jonathan Plowman wills the tract Buck Thickett (Ba. Co. Patent # 866 25 Acres) to Granddaughter Janthea Plowman daughter of deceased son Richard Plowman (1756-1792). In the late 1980's an old resident stated there had been tombstones

		located along a dirt road. Area was checked and no headstones were located. Coon Club Road & Leisters Church Road Westminster MD. Area of 39.588199° -76.925633°
J. Carey Shipley 1792-1823	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-18. One stone remains and was moved to a barn northwest of the original location. Land is the location of the tract Peters Purchase (Ba. Co. # 3810 100 Acres 1756) patented to Peter Shipley. Flohr Avenue Eldersburg MD. Area of 39.395263° -76.967582°
Judge Joshua H. Shipley 1812-1880 Mary A. Shipley 1812-1891	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 6-33. List Ca. Co. Deed LDM 174-440 1941 except family burial ground 120' square reserved in the will of Mary A. Shipley (Ca. Co. GMP 6-377 1890). Joshua H. Shipley (D. 1880) wills the farm to his wife Mary A. Shipley (Ca. Co. Will GMP 5-93). William O. Shipley (son of Mary A. Shipley) then inherits the farm by the will of Mary A. Shipley (Ca. Co. Will GMP 6-377 1891). William O. Shipley sells the farm in 1896 (Ca. Co. Deed BFC 82-477). No headstones found. Farm location matches Carroll County 1877 Atlas. Marriottsville Road & Walden Way Eldersburg MD. Area of 39.387658° -76.906682°
Lewis Shipley	Ca. Co.	Ca. Co. Deed 32-106 (1865) Graveyard reserved. Several deeds after 1865 mention the graveyard. Same as Carroll County Cemeteries 6-38. Sykesville MD. Gorsuch Switch Road. Area of 39.362545° -76.938851°
Snowden Family John Baptist Snowden 1737-1779 Francis Snowden 1757-1812	Ca. Co.	Baltimore Co. Deed WG -157 1820. States Lot 3 for 91 acres laid out for Francis Snowden heirs. Except a parcel of 3 perches for a burial ground. John Baptist Snowden 1737-1779 obtained by patent in 1765 (Snowdens Chance (Ba. Co. #4536 38 Acres) the land in the area where the burial ground is located. The land was willed with other land to son Francis Snowden (Ba. Co. Will Vol. 3-377 1763-1784). The house of John Baptist Snowden still stands and is located at 2819 Old Liberty Road Eldersburg MD. Burial ground location unknown. Williams Family Prudence Williams	Ca. Co.	Carroll County Cemeteries 4-42. Ca. Co. Deed JBB 17-165 1850 (Equity case) Thomas Williams deeds 152 acres to Burgess Nelson part of Peach Brandy Forrest except 1/2 acre which has been and is still

D. 1847 Husband Shadrach?		used as a burying ground. Carroll Co. Maryland 1837 Tax list Prudence Williams with 154 acres of Peach Brandy Forrest. Prudence Williams is listed in the Ba. Co. Census for years 1820-1830 & Ca. Co. 1840. Prudence Williams dies in 1847 and leaves the farm to son James Williams (Ca. Co. Will JB 1-456 1847). No headstones found. Deer Park Road & Sykesville Road Finksburg MD. Area of 39.511917° -76.973347°
Nicholas Wilson 1758-1836 Ruth Frizzell Wilson Wife	Ca. Co.	Ca. Co. Deed JS 10-198 106 Acres 1849 except family burial ground for the descendants of Nicholas Wilson. Ba. Co. Will 1836-1838 Vol. 16-77 Nicholas Wilson wills to eldest and only son John Wilson my plantation known by the name of Windsor Forrest. Wilson descendants interviewed in 1984 and recalled gravestones in a field which has since been plowed. Source: Carroll County Cemeteries 6-23. Klees Mill Road south of Bartholow Road Eldersburg MD. Area of 39.437429° -76.996040°

Ensey Family Graveyard	Fr. Co.	Richard Coomes Sr. & Dennis Ensey obtained patent for tract Coomes His Inheritance in 1749 (Fr. Co. Patent # 975 203 Acres). Richard Coomes Sr. dies 1751 then Dennis Ensey obtains patent for tract Coomes His Inheritance Resurveyed 1751 (Fr. Co. Patent # 975 374 Acres). Two headstones located: Rachel Ensey 1782-1854 & ? Ensey Died 1805 & his wife Died 1832 (2 names on same stone). Fr. Co. Administration Bonds page 177 list Richard Ensey 1805. Fr Co. Administration Account Richard Ensey page 304 1806-1809 shows distribution to widow & 6 children (Not listed). John Jones 1743-1824 Hannah Crapster Jones 1755-1835 Absalom Jones	Fr. Co.	John Jones 1743-1824 owned the land where Phebe Jones D. 1822 headstone is located. Maryland Historical Trust File No.F-8-121 States gable stone inscribed "John Jones 1820". John, Hannah & Absalom Jones are now at Central Church New London. Note: Central Church wasn't built until 1843. Holdcraft (1956) shows road was relocated. The road near the house was greatly altered from viewing early 1900 topo maps. Phebe Jones headstone is 1 mile west of Central Church on Lorien Court.
