Graveyard ¼ acre reserved. Adelia Marriott D. 1857 Intestate (d/o Charles Hammond) wife of Alpheus W. Marriott (Married Barbara Robinson in 1879). Alpheus W. Marriott died 21 Sep 1880. Adelia Marriott D. 1857 is buried in Fairmount Cemetery Libertytown MD. Charles Hammond D. <1820 married 1803 Elizabeth Hammond (of Vachel Hammond). Charles Hammond patented Hammonds Request in 1813 Fr. Co. Patent# 1799 1030 Acres. Charles Hammond along with his sisters Ariana & Rachel Hammond obtained the land which makes up Hammonds Request from their father John Hammond (of A.A. Co.) by Fr Co. Deed WR 8-223 1788. Land went to minor children Adelia & Charles Hammond Jr. (of Charles Hammond) D. <1820. John Hammond (A.A. Co.) married Martha Hawkins. John Hammond D. 1806 was the son of Nathan Hammond D. 1762 & Anne Welsh D. 1780. Quinn Road & Hall Road New Market MD. Location where the house stood is now a subdivision. Co.	<p>Christian Kemp (1715-1790) obtained the tract Dispatch in 1743 (PG Co. Patent #652 230 Acres) where his stone house and burial ground are located. Burial ground is located behind 5009 Switzer Barn Lane Frederick MD. 39.371770°-77.448695°. No headstones remain.</p> <p>History of Carrollton Manor William J. Grove (1922) states there are several very old graveyards in the field. The book shows a photo of the Christian Kemp 1715-1790 headstone. Also states C. Newton Thomas has at his residence on West 4th St. in Frederick a tombstone he brought from one of the graveyards on the farm. The inscription is in German. What happened to the Christian Kemp headstone is unknown. Holdcraft Records-Dorothy Kemp 13 MY 1765 3 DE 1831, Frederick Kemp 11 FE 1747 15 FE 1814, Frederick Kemp 23 NO 1795 16 FE 1814 graves were moved to Mt. Olivet after 1957. No record of Elizabeth Kemp Staley (1783-1814) is found at Mt. Olivet. Will 11-18 1819). Jonathan Manro died in 1848 and the estate ended up in Chancery Court. Baltimore Sun 4 Dec 1849 advertised sale of the farm by decree of the Chancery Court. States “Valuable farm of 520 acres which formerly belonged to James Conner and afterwards Jonathan Manro both deceased and is now in the</p>

Unknown if James Conner and wife & Jonathan Manro and wife were moved or still remain in the family burial ground. George W. Manro 1810-1891 was the son of Jonathan Manro (1766-1848) & Sarah Conner. Sarah Manro was the daughter of James Conner D. 1819 and Elizabeth Conner. Democratic Advocate 30 May 1891. George W. John Justice Jr. obtained the land in 1772 from his father (Fr. Co. Deed P-220) where the burial ground is thought to be located. No record found that the burying ground was reserved. Indenture made April 18, 1792 Whereas Rudolph Keller of Frederick County, Maryland in his life time purchased of Jacob Funck "Lot Number 276" in the Town of Hamburg and Rudolph did not by his last will make any deposition of the lot whereby it descended to Frederick Keller his eldest son charged with the dower of Julianna Keller, widow of Rudolph Keller, and whereas the lot descended to Jacob Keller by the death of Frederick Keller his eldest brother without issue and whereas Julianna Keller, widow of Rudolph Keller and her son Jacob Keller. Children-Frederick Keller D. 1832 Frederick Keller D. 1832 married Catherine Hughes (1799-1835) 30 Sep 1818 Fr. Co. MD. Children-Charles J. Keller, Dewit C. Jacob Keller Jr. D.1824 married 31 Dec. 1816 Fr. Co. MD. Mary Ann Eader. Children-Adeline, Eli, Joseph, Otho, Jacob and Jemina A. Keller. Fr. Co. MD. Source Frederick County Equity Record HS 6-331 1839 & Fr. Co. MD Marriage Records. Burial location unknown.

Henry T. Keller D. 1863

Henry T. Keller 1783-1863 married 28 Aug 1807 Fr. Co. MD. Nancy Eader D. Children-Louisa Keller Shoup (1810-1873) & Rebecca Keller Lare. **Fr. Co. Equity Record HS 4-287 1838 for Jonathan Eader (D. 1837) shows his sister Elizabeth Eader (Deceased) wife of Henry T. Keller.** Both Henry T. Keller (1783-1863) & daughter Louisa Keller Shoup (1810-1873) are buried at Mt. Olivet Cemetery Frederick MD. Burial location of Elizabeth Eader Keller D. <1837 is unknown. Note: 1807 marriage record list Nancy Eader. Is Elizabeth Eader Keller same as Nancy?

Rudolph Keller D. 1850's

Rudolph Keller D. 1850's married 18 May 1822 Fr. Co. MD. Elizabeth Hooper D. 1871 Age 71. Children-Christopher, Annie E. and George W. Keller. Fr. Co. Equity Record ES 1-419 1851 Rudolph Keller failed to repay a mortgage he had taken out from John Markel on the 35 acres of land he obtained in 1824. Equity record states Rudolph Keller refused to give up the property and a court order was brought to remove him. George W. Keller (son of Rudolph Keller) got the property back in 1867 (Fr. Co. Deed CM 1-60). Burial location of Rudolph Keller D. 1850's believed to be Keller Family Burial Ground

Jacob Keller Sr. D. 1822 and in 1824 a partition of 129 acres was made between his 3 sons Jacob Keller Jr., Henry T. Keller and Rudolph Keller. The portion where the burial ground is located went to Rudolph Keller</p>		
<p>Joseph O. Keller (D.1900) Burial Keller Family Burial Ground?</p>	<p>Fr. Co.</p>	<p>The Citizen, Frederick MD. 9 March 1900. Joseph O. Keller of New Market died March 1 1900 in his eightieth year. Interment made in the family graveyard. A Joseph C. Keller (Miller) born circa 1820 shows up in Census Records 1850-1880. No death certificate found. Joseph O. Keller (D.1900) is believed to be the son of Jacob Keller Jr. (D.1824) & Mary Ann Eader Keller. Obituary list Cornelius Mercer as one of the pallbearers. Frederick Co. 1873 Atlas shows C. Mercer living across the road from George W. Keller.</p>
